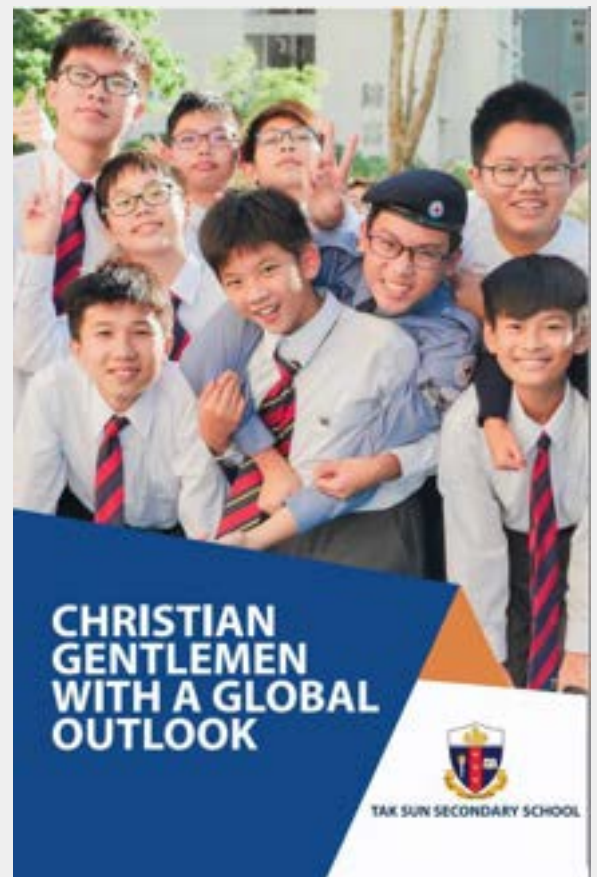

Our curriculum allows every junior form student to have balanced exposure in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

We organize a wide variety of STEM activities and enrichment programs ranging from Robomaster AI robotic tournaments, Drone swarm flying, AI LEGO programs, VR and AR to metaverse, etc. We also have a Programming and STEM Team in our school for talented students to serve and demonstrate to others.

English Language Bridging

Homework Clinic

- Virtues programme

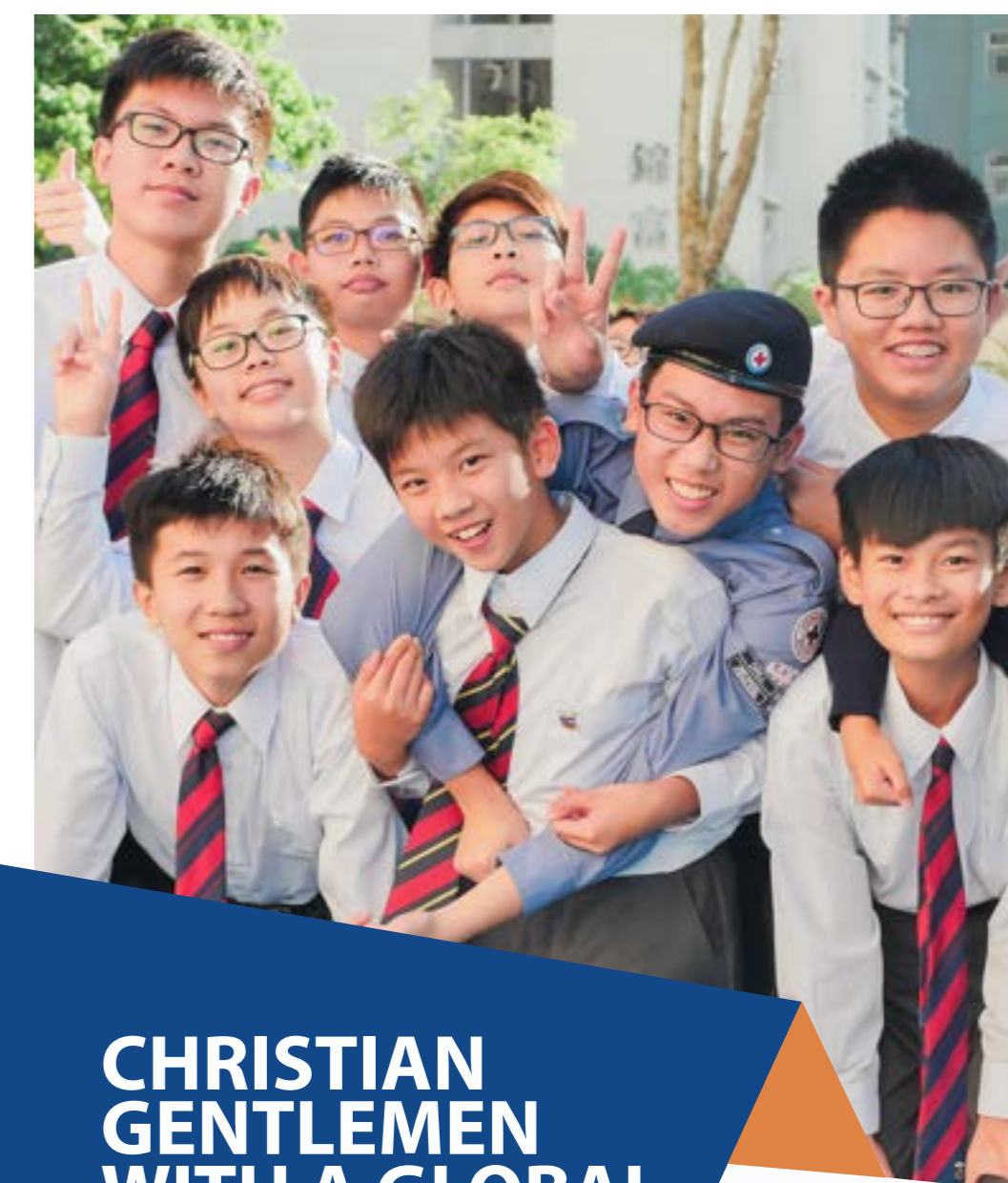
Our school is founded on Catholic Christian values with an aim to offer a whole person education to students.

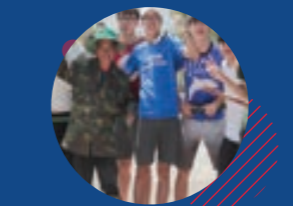

Co-Curricular Activities

In order to cultivate in our boys appreciation for arts and team spirit, we have organized OSOSA (One Student – One Service or Art) for all Form 1-3 students. They are required to join OSOSA for musical or uniform group training after school and at weekends.

- Uniform Groups

Scouts, Sea Cadets, Red Cross and Junior Police Call have regular meetings and camps at weekends. They learn leadership skills and a spirit of discipline.



- Music

Students learn singing or musical instruments: cello, clarinet, euphonium, flute, French horn, percussion, saxophone, trombone, trumpet, tuba and violin. Our junior and senior choirs, string orchestra and wind band are given opportunities to join competitions and perform in public.
